About Holy Apostles Soup Kitchen

Holy Apostles Soup Kitchen is the largest emergency food program in New York – second largest in the nation – serving over 1,000 hot, nutritious meals every week day, including holidays, from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., to the hungry and homeless. Soup kitchen guests come from all over the five boroughs of New York City, and for many of them, this is the only meal they will eat that day.

In addition to the food program, Holy Apostles also offers the following services to those in need:

- On-site medical and chiropractic services, social service and resource counseling, computer lab, writers' workshop, discussion groups, art workshops and meditation classes.
- Career and job application prep through resume writing support, haircut and clothing vouchers, and business attire from our clothing pantry.
- Essential photo IDs, mailing addresses and MetroCards
- Over 300 hundred coats every winter.
- Health and hygiene items including toiletries, including soap, razors, shampoo, toothpaste, and toothbrushes on a daily basis.

In more than 33 years of servicing New York's hungry, Holy Apostles Soup Kitchen has never turned anyone away from its services.
